### Eligibility..

- ◆ 18 Years or Older
- ◆ Date of release and program entry must be within 180 days
- ◆ Non-Violent Ex-Offender

Entrance into the program is based on the availability of open slots.

CODI provides services through funding by the DOL/ETA to non-violent ex-offenders upon their release from jail. The goal of the program is to assist individuals to become law abiding, self sufficient members of the community through employment .
